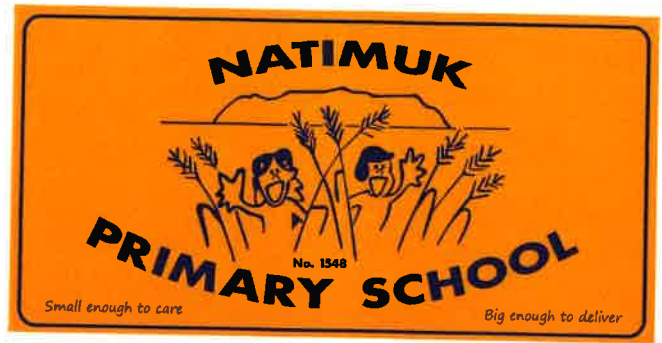

Year 3 - 6 Report

In Literacy the Year 6s are reading *Mulga Bill's Bicycle*. They felt the illustrations gave a good indication of what the poem would be like and after reading they were right. All students have had extra time to spend on their free writing. They have been writing great stories of their own creation and are having time to finish them.

The Maths focus for this week is proper, improper and mixed fractions. We have also been adding fractions of unlike denominators. There is lots of practise for these on the homework as well. The 3s and 4s have been doing division with and without remainders.

Science

P- 2 Earth and Space Science - Daily and seasonal changes in our environment affect everyday life. The children had a discussion about reading temperature and what tools help us to do that. They created their own thermometer to show if the weather was hot, warm, cool or cold.

3 - 6 Earth and Space Science - The Earth is part of a system of planets orbiting around a star (the sun). The task this week was to read about Galileo Galilei of the 1600s and his views about the planets and the Universe. It raised many interesting questions which helped the discussion.
